AT&T has completed its annual, 21-state pole and conduit rate calculation review, conducted in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in 47 CFR 1.1409, and hereby revises its Ohio pole attachment and conduit occupancy rates for 2019 consistent with the FCC rate calculation formulas and with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) rules set forth in OAC 4901:1-3.

Provided here are the rate changes which will take effect January 1, 2019:

- 1. The Pole Attachment Fee is being decreased from \$2.57 to \$2.34 per foot per year.
- 2. The Conduit Attachment Fee (per foot of innerduct occupied) is being decreased from \$0.51 to \$0.50.
- 3. The Conduit Attachment Fee (per foot where there is no innerduct installed full duct) is being decreased from \$0.77 to \$0.75.

Customer notice is not required for rate decreases and thus, none will be provided.
