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ALJ JENNINGS: I'm going to go on the record. The Ohio Power Siting Board has assigned for public hearing at this time and place Case No. 18-0031-EL-BTX, which is captioned In the Matter of the Application of AEP Ohio Transmission Company for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Pine Ridge Switch-Heppner 138 kilovolt Transmission Line Project.

My name is Doug Jennings, and I'm the Administrative Law Judge assigned by the Ohio Power Siting Board to preside over this hearing. With me are staff members who are available for questions after today's hearing.

At this point in the proceeding I'll ask the parties to enter an appearance on the record.

MS. BLEND: Thank you, your Honor. Good evening. On behalf of AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc., Christen M. Blend, American Electric Power Service Corporation, 1 Riverside Plaza, 29th floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215, and with me this evening are members of AEP's right-of-way and siting teams who are also available to answer questions after the

hearing.

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ALJ JENNINGS: Thank you. I'll make a statement for the record. The subject of this evening's hearing is the application filed on March 29th, 2018 to construct a 138 kilovolt transmission line project in Jackson County, Ohio.

This public hearing is only one aspect of this process. I would note that another hearing will be scheduled later this month which will be an evidentiary hearing, and that will be held in Columbus, Ohio.

The purpose of this evening's hearing is to receive comments from the public regarding AEP Ohio Transmission Company's application. This is not intended to be a question and answer session, but is intended as an opportunity for local community members to express their opinions about the company's proposal.

I'll note that the Board Staff has filed a Report of Investigation that was filed on September 25th, 2018. I would emphasize that the Board's Report of Investigation contains recommendations that the Board is not bound to follow, but will consider in this case.

Tonight's case is being transcribed by a

Court Reporter who will take down any testimony that's provided.

I will note that we were prepared to begin this hearing at 6:00. We waited for anyone who may be interested to testify to appear in that time period. It is my understanding that no one has signed up to testify. It has been confirmed that no one has expressed an interest in testifying.

So with that, I will wait for another five minutes and see if anyone shows up late. If no one shows up within that time I will adjourn the proceedings. Let's go off the record.

(Recess taken.)

ALJ JENNINGS: Let's go back on the record. Five minutes has gone by. There have been no witnesses to show up to testify, therefore this hearing is adjourned.
