## **II. COMMENTS**

On July 26, 2018, the Staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (“Staff”) filed its Review and Recommendation in this case. In its review, Staff found the Company has appropriately included in its SCRR only those restoration costs incurred due to major storms in Ohio, with the exception of recommended adjustments totaling \$63,371. These adjustments are for expenses relating to meals, labor, stock issuance, stock returns, and stores handling.

The Company does not oppose the Staff’s recommended adjustments totaling \$63,371. This would reduce the annual revenue requirement from \$1,768,590 to \$1,705,219. As such, the monthly billed amount for residential customers will be reduced to \$0.20 from \$0.21; the non-residential customers will see a reduction to \$0.81 from \$0.84; and the rate for private outdoor lighting will remain unchanged at \$0.06.

## **III. CONCLUSION**

DP&L appreciates the opportunity to provide comments and requests that the Commission approve the recovery mechanism requested in the Application with the adjustments listed in Staff’s Review and Recommendations.
