On November 26, 2018, the Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB") Staff issued a Report of Investigation approving the Letter of Notification subject to a number of conditions. Within this set of conditions, Condition No. 1 requires:

Prior to the commencement of construction activities in areas that require permits or authorizations by federal or state laws and regulations, the Applicant shall obtain and comply with such permits or authorizations. The Applicant shall provide copies of permits and authorizations, including all supporting documentation, to Staff within seven days of issuance or receipt by the Applicant.

In compliance with Staff Report Condition No. 1, attached is a copy of the Auglaize County Permit to Make Installation and/or Work Along or Across County Roads.

## APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO MAKE INSTALLATION AND/OR WORK ALONG OR ACROSS COUNTY ROADS

Application is hereby made by Dominion Energy Address: 3420 Springside Drive, Akron, Ohio 44321

I/We agree to the following conditions:

- 1. Pipe culverts to be installed as per plan.
- 2. That traffic will be maintained at all times, unless permission is granted by the County to close the road.
- 3. That disturbance to road surface and shoulders will be kept at a minimum and that trenches will be backfilled with gravel and tamped, so that settlement of material will be minimized. If settlement does occur, additional suitable material will be put into place and compacted. Natural backfill is permitted as long as center of trench is at least 4' from the edge of the pavement.
- 4. That the road surface at the trench will be replaced with material of the type that was removed (or other material suitable to the County) and that the new surface will conform with the grade of the undisturbed surface.
- 5. That lights, signs barricades and, if necessary, flagmen and watchmen, will be placed on the job for the protection of traffic at all times, day and night, during the time this work is being done and that instructions given by the County, as to handling of traffic, will be fully complied with.
- 6. Any drainage tiles encountered will be repaired or replaced and any drainage problems arising from this installation will be the responsibility of the applicant hereafter.
- 7. If, in the future, improvements or relocations are made to any of the above portions of County Roads, it will be the financial responsibility of the applicant or new owners to move or relocate such installations at the request of the County as per Ohio law.
- 8. That I/We assume the responsibility for and will save the County harmless from any and all claims for personal injuries and property damages, caused by Dominions negligent or willful acts or omissions during construction.
- 9. All driveway culverts must be either reinforced concrete or smooth walled steel casing.
- 10. All buried utility lines shall be installed a minimum of 36" below the flow line of all storm sewers within the road right-of-way.
