ALJ SEE: The Ohio Power Siting Board has scheduled for public hearing at this time and place Case No. 18-279-EL-BTX which is entitled in the Matter of the Application of AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc., for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for Its Glencoe-Speidel 138 Kilovolt Transmission Line Rebuild Project.

My name is Greta See, and I am an Attorney Examiner with the Legal Department of the Ohio Power Siting Board. I am filling in for the assigned Attorney Examiner Dan Fullin. My colleague John Pawley, who you -- who is also employed by the Board, and you likely met when you first came in, is -- can answer questions about the process if you choose to leave before the hearing gets concluded; or if you wait a few minutes afterwards, Mr. Pawley and I will address any further process questions you might have.

Mr. Pawley also asked if you wanted to offer testimony tonight. At this point no one has signed up to offer testimony, but if you do, when you come forward, I'll ask you to be sworn in or affirm

At that hearing counsel for AEP Ohio Transmission and the Staff of the Ohio Power Siting Board will have an opportunity to present expert testimony in support of their positions.

And then the next step is for the Board to consider the application and the Staff's recommendation as to where the line should be located. As you also heard, it's approximately 13 miles long and there are two proposed routes, a preferred and an alternative route, and Staff has endorsed the preferred route.

With that information are there any questions regarding the Board's process or is there anyone present that wants to offer testimony tonight?
