Dear Chairman Haque:

AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc. (“AEP Ohio Transco”) submits the attached map clarifying Figure 1 contained in its applications filed in the above-referenced dockets. As reflected in AEP Ohio Transco’s applications and the staff reports issued in both dockets, AEP Ohio Transco will be removing the existing 69 kilovolt (kV) station equipment and structures from the existing Glencoe station in connection with these projects. AEP Ohio wishes to clarify, however, that the existing Glencoe station fence line will remain as a part of the station expansion and become a part of the final expanded station fence line, as depicted in the attached map. The existing Glencoe station ground grid also will be connected to, and become a part of, the expanded station’s ground grid.
