Construction will take place on land owned by AEP Ohio Transmission Co., Inc. Work begins next spring and will conclude toward the end of the year.

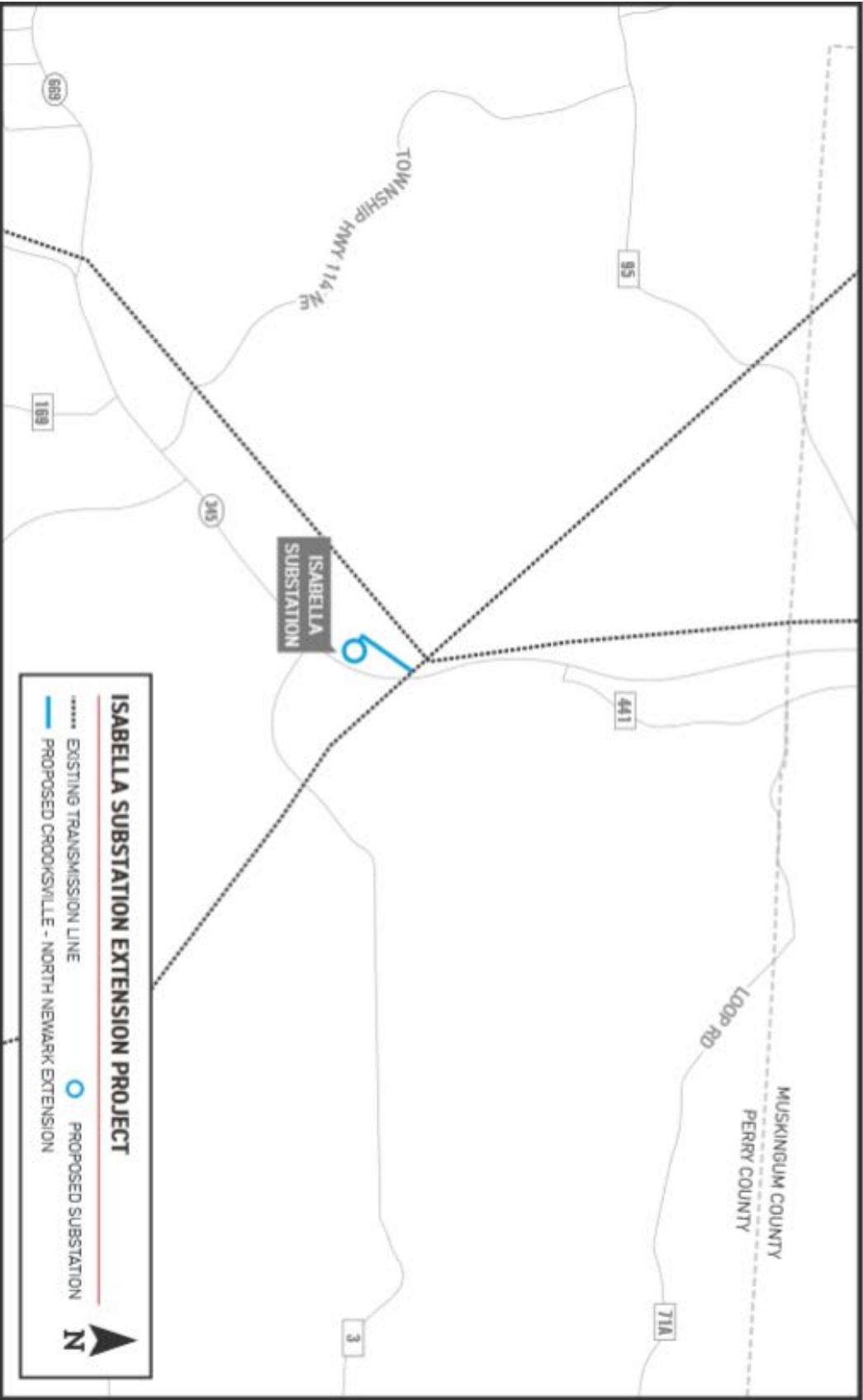

Construction will take place on land owned by AEP Ohio Transmission Co., Inc. Work begins next spring and will conclude toward the end of the year.

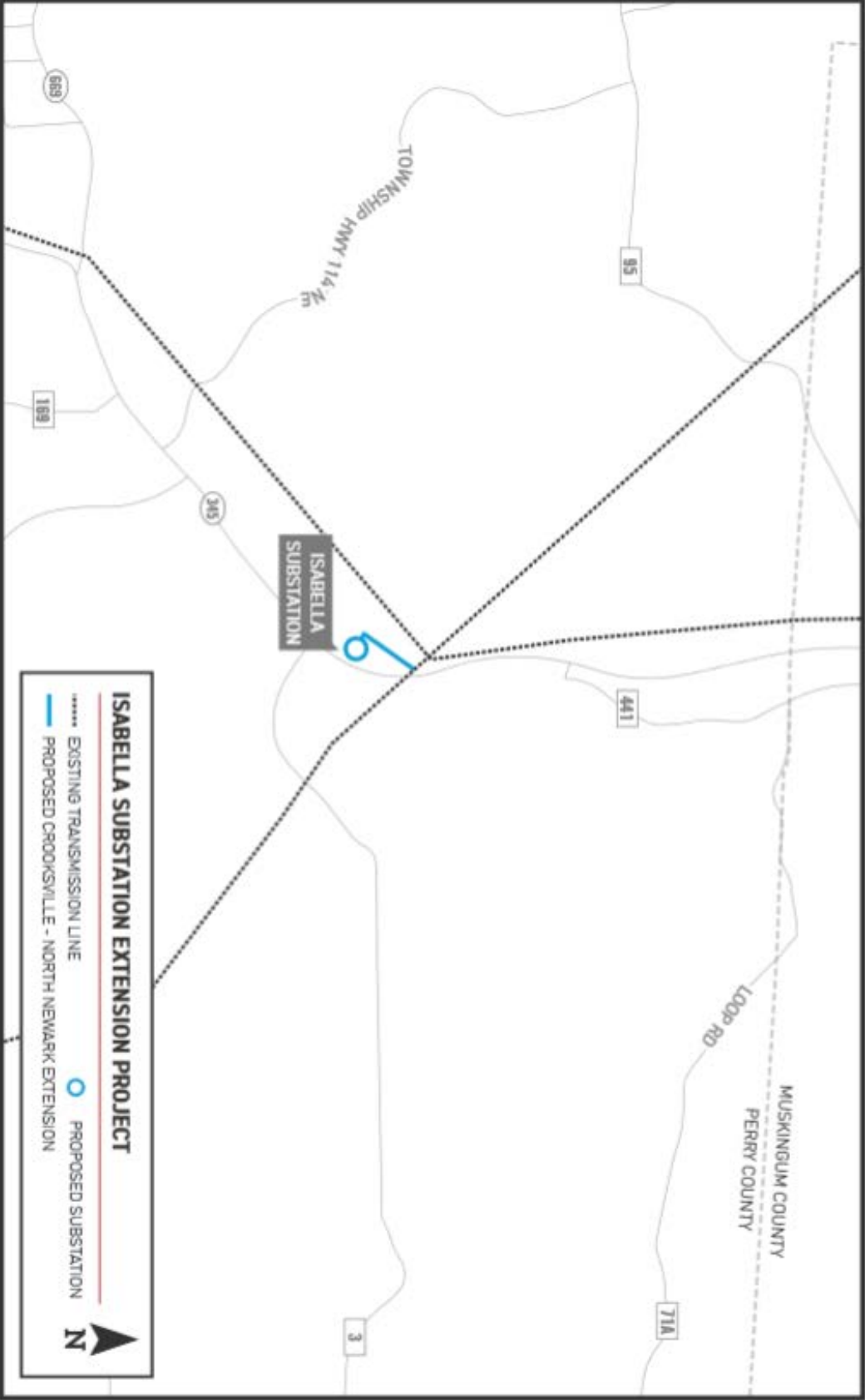

A bus route for local produce

NEW LEXINGTON — Ever wish the farmers market could come to you? Beginning next summer in coordination with the Perry County Health Department and Fern Hollow Farms that dream will soon become a reality.

As a part of the Creating Healthy Communities grant and funded through the Ohio Department of Health, the

Perry County Health Department has worked to support several start-up farms to bring more local produce to the community. The Director of Health Education for the health department, Deborah Raney, explained that creating healthy communities helps to fund a couple different initiatives. “It’s main focus is physical activity — Making the Healthy Choice is the Easy Choice — is their logo.

Make the healthy choice the easy choice and that’s by putting the opportunity for fresh local food and physical activity right in front of your face. You’re more likely to use it if it’s right in front of your face,” stated Raney. Raney goes on to add that Perry County is not a very bike-friendly community because of the hills and they’re working on creating a safer environment along with more playgrounds in the area.

The grant has a five-year cycle and the county is headed into the last year of its funding, so in 2020 they plan on reapplying for the funds to continue their projects for the community. The funding focuses on three communities right now, New Lexington, Somerset and Roseville.

For example, Roseville is a “food desert” right now as Raney explained — they have no grocery store but plans to open one in the near future after the receive a bit more funding.

By word of mouth, Raney found out about Olivia and Erik Peterson, co-founders of Fern Hollow Farms. Olivia and Erik first met in 2014 at a permaculture design course in Athens at a farm that exposed them to a lot of different concepts on community farming. It inspired them so much that they took a six-week quest

across the nation in search of farms doing similar work, learning how they ran their farms before starting their own.

“We came back from that just ready to go and that fall and winter was when we put together the crowd-funding campaign,” remarked Olivia.

The couple shared how they first put their roots in the ground during the campaign and were able to raise 114 percent of their goal, had a great volunteer turnout and planted 92 trees in one day.

“So I think from the start we’ve felt a lot of community support and have continued to develop that as a part of our mission,” expressed Erik.

In order to make food more accessible to communities like Roseville who might be in a food desert, they created the Veg Bus, a mobile farmer’s market that will have a bus route around the community. The old school bus was found on Craigslist and even painted by Guardian Aliens in Athens to represent the farmer’s market feel with bright colors and fresh produce.

The farm’s primary focus is on perennials but they have an annual garden and are working on organizing a multiple farmer food production co-op — bringing local food to the 21st century. Erik described it as the, “ease of Amazon meets the farmers

market.” Once they get their mobile farmer’s market up and running, folks will be able to go online, order their fresh produce and meet the Veg Bus during its bus route to pick up their order.

“It does take SNAP and EBT, it takes WIC, it takes senior discount coupons,” Raney excitedly shared. “We’re learning as we go, just like Olivia and Erik are too. Ultimately what I’d like to see is three or four veggie bus opportunities.”

In addition to providing healthy foods, their mission is to educate others. Fern Hollow Farm hosts 10 to 12 workshops each year and has had a great response. They

do farm-to-table dinners and love to share the culture of southeastern Ohio and Appalachia, so last year they hosted an Appalachian song and story night.

The farm also works with Job and Family Services to provide a summer youth employment program and have had four or five youth and young adults come to learn about sustainable farming and how to get fresh produce into a community.

“That’s always been a blast, we love doing that and even more this summer we’re getting requests from Boy Scout groups to come out and homeschooling groups and outdoor kindergarten groups,” shared Olivia.

Since working with Olivia and Erik, Raney has become more and more excited to finally bring this project into a reality.

“Isn’t the Veg Bus not the coolest thing?” she concluded.

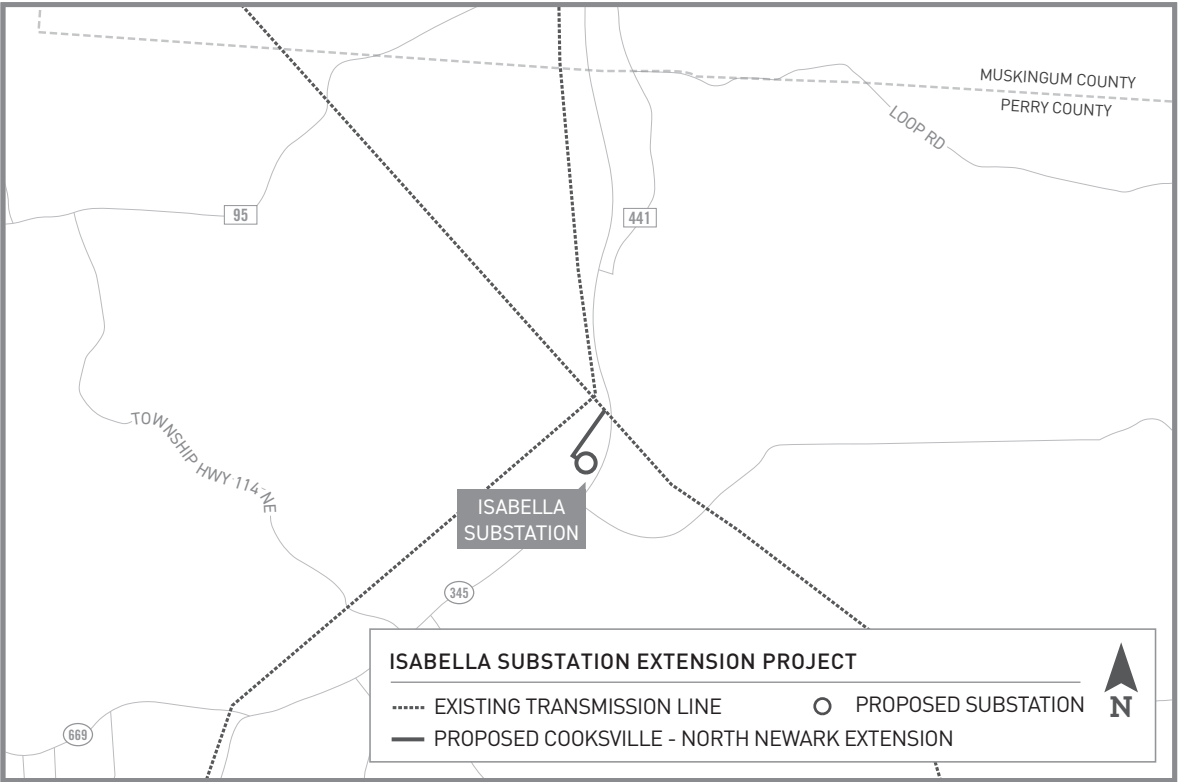
