Please docket the following comments in the case number above.

I am writing to comment on the request by Suburban Natural Gas request for another base price request. We are in a unique area where we do not have the same choice of suppliers as other Ohio residents served by one of the major distribution companies - in fact we have no choice. Suburban enjoys a monopoly in our area and will be benefiting from the extensive growth occurring in this part of southern Delaware county. Their argument seems to be that current customers need to help pay for the costs of extending their infrastructure so they can capture new revenue. Unlike other gas suppliers, we have no insight to their expense or profit structure given their private ownership. I believe that they should be able to leverage future revenue with bank debt rather than loading the cost onto the current captive customer base - customers that have no other choice but to move if they want cheaper energy costs.
