{¶ 1} On November 19, 2018, as amended on December 11, 2018, AUI Associates, Inc. filed an application for certification as a competitive retail electric aggregator/broker in Ohio.

{¶ 2} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10(A) provides that an application shall be deemed automatically approved pursuant to R.C 4928.08 upon the 31st day after the filing date. Further, Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10(A) provides that, upon good cause shown, an attorney examiner may suspend its consideration of an application.
