Dear Property Owner or Tenant:

Republic Wind, LLC ("Republic") is preparing to construct a wind farm on leased private land in Adams, Pleasant, Reed, Scipio and Thompson Townships (Seneca County) and Green Creek and York Townships (Sandusky County). The wind farm will consist of up to 58 wind turbine generators, along with access roads, electric collection cables, a substation, lay down yard(s), an operation and maintenance facility, and meteorological tower(s).

Please be assured that during work on the project described above, all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances will be fully adhered to.

Timeline for Construction of the Project

Construction of the Republic wind farm is expected to begin in the ____ quarter of 2018 and is scheduled to be in-service by the ____ quarter of 2019.

Restoration Activities:

Republic will restore any of your property which is disturbed to the state that it was in prior to Republic's construction activities. Once the work is complete, restoration will begin as soon as weather permits.

Draft Complaint Resolution Plan

PURPOSE: To ensure that the wind farm does not make living conditions materially worse for residents of the community by implementing a transparent and effective complaint resolution plan that will address concerns or problems voiced by members of the community.

BACKGROUND: Republic is committed to ensuring that an accessible process is in place for community members to voice concerns and for those concerns to be addressed as quickly and effectively as possible.

Maintaining a detailed record of all complaints and the resolutions that follow is an important aspect of the complaint resolution plan.

POLICY: The policy of Republic is to take all reasonable necessary actions to rectify legitimate interference or disturbances that are a direct result of the wind farm facilities. Where reasonable actions are implemented but do not minimize the interference or disturbance, Republic will compensate the impacted resident by entering into an agreement with the impacted resident that will provide annual compensation for the life of the wind farm project.

PROCEDURE:

- 1.) Republic will establish an 800-phone number prior to the wind farm being commercially operational and will ensure that the phone number is provided to the county commissioners, township trustees, emergency responders, the schools, and public libraries within the project area. A resident who has a complaint about the wind farm may either call the 800# and leave a message 24 hours a day or go to the Operations and Maintenance Facility [or local office ---give address, phone number, e-mail] for the wind farm during regular business hours to register a complaint.
- 2.) Republic will be responsible for keeping a logbook, which registers every complaint that is received. The logbook will contain all pertinent information about the person making the complaint, the issues surrounding the complaint and the date that the complaint was received. The logbook will also contain the resolution that Republic suggests, the date the complaining party agreed to the proposed resolution and the date when the proposed resolution was implemented. Republic personnel will generate a quarterly report based on the information recorded in the log book about the nature and resolution of all complaints received in that quarter and file the report with the Ohio Power Siting Board on the following date of each year (April 15th, July 15th, October, 15th and January 15th).

- 3.) Residents who register a complaint with Republic will receive correspondence from the company no later than 48 hours after registering the complaint. The intent of the initial correspondence is to garner more information from the individual's complaint. Within 30 days of the complaint being received Republic will initiate reasonable action to resolve the legitimate interference or disturbance that is a direct result of the wind farm facility.
- 4.) If Republic and the complaining resident cannot agree to a resolution proposed by Republic or one negotiated with the complaining resident, Republic will provide a summary of the complaint and proposed resolution to the complaining resident so that the resident may bring the complaint to the Ohio Power Siting Board.
