We strongly oppose the Alamo Solar project as a homeowner in close proximity of this project, If this project is allowed, my property values as well as those my neighbors and a gated community of approximately 1400 homes located behind and adjoining my property, will plummet, There is also a question of what the impact would be in regard to the Lakengren recreational lake, also a part of this community. What is the chemical runoff going to do to the lake? Will the grass waterways to prevent erosion be maintained across many of the fields which were prime agricultural land. Also adjacent to this area is a wildlife reserve as well as a large Boy Scout reservation. Wildlife is abundant in this area between , Rt. 127 and Paint Creek Rd. The fencing of the area is going to deter wildlife and force new paths across existing farmlands and residential areas. This could be detrimental to farm animals as well as domestic animals.

Also we have a large concern with the "heat island" that would be produced the by the panels . Would this create a climate change for this area?
