On July 11, 2017 Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. ("Columbia") filed a Construction Notice, pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code 4906-6-03(C) and 4906-6-05, concerning a proposed pipeline relocation project known as the I-75 Mandatory Relocation Project (the "Project"). The Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB") Staff issued its report October 3, 2017, recommending automatic approval of Columbia's application in this proceeding on October 10, 2017, provided that two conditions contained therein were satisfied. On October 6, 2017, Columbia accepted those two conditions. Columbia began its construction on the Project on November 1, 2018.

Per Ohio Admin. Code 4906-6-11(D), Columbia is providing notification to the OPSB that it completed construction on the Project on February 11, 2019.
