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# MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED RULING 

On February 1, 2017, as supplemented, Icebreaker filed an application for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the Icebreaker Project to be located in Lake Erie eight miles off the shore of Cleveland, Ohio in Cuyahoga County.

On September 4, 2018, Icebreaker, Business Network for Offshore Wind, Inc., the Sierra Club, Indiana/Kentucky/Ohio Regional Council of Carpenters, and the Ohio Environmental Council filed a Joint Stipulation and Recommendation for adoption by the OPSB. The evidentiary hearing in this matter commenced on September 24, 2018. At the conclusion of the hearing, the ALJs determined that the initial and reply briefs should be filed by November 30, 2018, and January 8 , 2019, respectively. The ALJ has granted several extensions of time of the briefing schedule and, currently, February 19,2019 , is the due date for the filing of a revised stipulation or a proposed revised briefing schedule.

The parties have met several times since conclusion of the hearing and continued their discussions on a possible revised settlement in this matter. The parties have made great progress and the Applicant believes that additional time will prove helpful in reaching a resolution of the issues. Therefore, it is necessary that the Applicant request additional time for review and discussion on possible settlement.

Accordingly, the Applicant proposes that the OPSB grant an extension for the filing of a revised stipulation or, in the alternative, a proposed revised briefing schedule to March 8, 2019.

Given the short time frame, Icebreaker requests that this motion be granted on an expedited basis for good cause shown.
