## **Responses to Staff's First Data Request**

1. The capacity modeling data of the pipeline currently and with the upgrade.

## **RESPONSE:**

- a. 8" capacity = 120,000 mcfd
- b. 12" capacity = 265,000 mcfd
- c. Note: Based on a MAOP of 1565 psig. The pipeline pressure may range between = 1555 psig and 200 psig
- 2. The % operating capacity expected at peak day.

## **RESPONSE:**

- a. 8" = 60%
- b. 12" = 25%
- c. Note: Above percentages based on normal operations.
- 3. Why they must use ILI instead of the alternatives.

## **RESPONSE:**

ILI provides detailed information of the internal defects of the pipeline including corrosion, cracks and deformation. The alternative, hydrostatic testing does not provide a comprehensive internal inspection. It merely determines whether a line is defective. Also, ILI allows DEO to clean the line during the inspection and allows the pipeline to be inspected without interrupting operation of the pipeline. Hydrostatic testing does not provide for either one of these benefits. Please confirm the existing line has no protective coating.
