- 1. I don't feel there is a need as much as there are companies taking advantage of the tax production credit, PILOT programs ,ETC
- 2. Wind energy is not 100% green and efficient
- 3. The setbacks in Ohio are too close; non participating residents are in the foot prints of these projects and are being exposed to noise, shadow flicker and infrasound and the health consequences of these

The sound study for my area of the Emerson Creek Project will be misleading- the monitor was placed at a residence on State Rte. 224 (traffic, trucks, farm machinery); the turbines will be placed down the road .3 mile to approx. 1mile; the noise at these places is not the same as on State Rte. 224
