I have multiple concerns about all of the proposed wind farms in Ohio, especially in Huron, Seneca, and Crawford Counties

1. I don't feel there is a need as much as there are companies taking advantage of the tax production credit, PILOT programs ,ETC
2. Wind energy is not 100% green and efficient
3. The setbacks in Ohio are too close; non participating residents are in the foot prints of these projects and are being exposed to noise, shadow flicker and infrasound and the health consequences of these
4. The process seems to be sneaky; I said NO to a wind turbine and moved on; next thing I am getting letters from attorneys that we are in the foot print of 2 proposed projects; not everyone subscribes to the county paper where meetings are posted,, etc
5. The public informational meeting is nothing but a few poster boards and a few representatives; sometimes questions are answered, sometimes they are avoided, or misleading information is given
6. The sound study for my area of the Emerson Creek Project will be misleading- the monitor was placed at a residence on State Rte. 224 (traffic, trucks, farm machinery); the turbines will be placed down the road .3 mile to approx. 1mile; the noise at these places is not the same as on State Rte. 224
