On November 14, 2016, the Ohio Rail Development Commission (ORDC) authorized funding for Wheeling & Lake Erie Railroad (WE) to install mast mounted and cantilevered lights and gates at the following location:

On January 18, 2017, the Commission issued a Finding and Order approving the project and requiring project completion by October 18, 2017.

On October 13, 2017, WE filed a request for a 30 day extension. The electric company, Ohio Edison is having trouble setting the electric service poles due to sewer work the City of Akron is completing in the area. WE has installed the foundations and warning devices and has a little more circuitry work and conduit work yet to complete. Staff recommended the 30 day extension.

The crossing project has been completed and is in-service as follows:
