**MOTION TO INTERVENE AS A PARTY OF
PREBLE SOIL & WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO**

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4906.08 and Ohio Administrative Code (“OAC”) Rule 4906-2-12, Preble County Soil & Water Conservation District, Preble County, Ohio, submits its notice of intervention in the above referenced proceeding. On February 11, 2019, the Preble County Soil & Water Conservation District was served a copy of the Angelina Solar I, LLC (“Angelina”) application to develop, build, and operate the Angelina Solar Farm, an 80 MW solar-powered electric generation facility to be located in Preble County, Ohio.

In accordance with OAC Rule 4906-2-12 the Preble County Soil & Water Conservation District states as follows:


- The Preble County Soil & Water Conservation District is the duly elected body for Preble County and has taken the required action to intervene, as certified by the attached resolution (Attachment A).
- The proposed facility is to be located entirely within Preble County, Ohio, with such area under the jurisdiction of the Preble County Soil & Water Conservation District.
- The Preble County Soil & Conservation District intends to intervene, as the elected representative of the citizens of Preble County, Ohio, because it has extensive interest in the

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proposed project and proceedings in regards to ensuring the waterways, drainage and the environment are dealt with in a way that does no harm to the county.

- The interest of the Preble County Soil & Water Conservation District is not and cannot be represented by another party; the Preble County Soil & Water Conservation District will contribute to a just and expeditious resolution; and the Preble County Soil & Water Conservation District will not unduly delay the proceedings or unjustly prejudice any party.



Mike Broermann, Donn Kolb, Keith Schmidt, Kip Denlinger, and Jim Leedy



Kip Denlinger seconded the motion and the results are as follow:


