



EXHIBIT C

AT&T Ohio hereby revises Part 3 Section 1 of its AT&T Ohio Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 20, to update its non-recurring charges (NRCs) as follows:

	Current Rate	New Rate
Service Order Charge	\$20.00	\$29.00
Central Office Connection Charge	\$ 5.50	\$ 5.50
Line Connection Charge	\$11.00	\$14.50

Generally, the above NRCs are assessed for work done by the Company to establish, change, move or transfer service. When applicable to the establishment of new residential Basic Local Exchange Service (BLES), the total service establishment charge will increase from \$36.50 to \$49.00.

ILECs are permitted to increase the rates, terms and conditions and non-recurring fees related to BLES. Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C.) 4927.12 provides the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) with the authority to prescribe by rule the manner in which the terms, conditions, and non-recurring fees related to BLES shall be tariffed. In its November 30, 2016 Finding and Order in *Case No. 14-1554-TP-ORD In the Matter of the Commission's Review of Chapter 4901:1-6 of the Ohio Administrative Code*, the Commission found that rather than capping ILEC BLES installation and reconnection fees at September 13, 2010 levels, ILECs will be granted the ability to increase such charges via a tariff amendment application, subject to an appropriateness review. This provision in O.A.C. 4901:1-6-14(J), noted here, took effect on May 24, 2018.

(J) BLES installation and reconnection fees

Any ILEC nonrecurring service charges for installation and reconnection of a single residential or primary business BLES line shall be included in the BLES tariff and may be increased through a thirty-day application for tariff amendment (ATA) filing. A standard of reasonableness will be applied to nonrecurring service charges for installation and reconnection. Applications for increases to nonrecurring reconnection charges requires a customer notice to be filed in accordance with rule 4901:1-6-07 of the Administrative Code.

The new rates are reasonable by the several objective criteria.

First, the same rates are assessed in all but one other AT&T state and implementation of these rates support the Company's efforts to standardize rates.

The new rates are in line with the rates charged by other larger Ohio ILECs which range from \$25.70 to \$54.35, and in fact, represent the median total rate amongst the five largest Ohio ILECs.

AT&T Ohio's residential service establishment charge has been \$36.50 since October 21, 1995. The NRCs comprising the total service establishment charge have not changed for over 23 years. Had the NRCs increased to the proposed rates on an annual basis, the total annual rate increase would have been approximately \$0.54 per year.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics consumer price index (CPI), prices in 2017 (the most current year available) were 60.84% (1.40% annualized) higher than prices in 1995. Had the AT&T Ohio rates kept pace with the CPI, the current service establishment charge would be \$58.71. Its rates have not risen, and new residential AT&T Ohio service has continued to be established at the 1995 rate for over 23 years.
