21	There being none, the subject matter
22	of this evening's public hearing is the
23	application filed by Paulding Wind Farm IV
24	on October 17th, 2018, to construct a
25	138-kilovolt transmission line to be

located in Benton Township, Paulding County, Ohio.

This public hearing is only one aspect of the process for this case. I would note that the adjudicatory hearing for this proceeding is scheduled to take place later this month at the offices of the Ohio Power Siting Board, which is in Columbus, Ohio.

In this case the Applicant submits that the purpose of the transmission line is to support the Timber Road IV Wind Farm certified in Case No. 18-91-EL-BGN. The proposed transmission line will run from the Timber Road IV Wind Farm substation to the existing Timber Road III generation lead line. The transmission line will be approximately 2.89 miles long.

According to the application, land use and proximity to the proposed facility is predominantly agricultural. Temporary disturbances to agricultural land usage, excuse me, uses would amount to approximately 18 acres for the preferred route and 40 acres for the alternative route. The Applicant avers that's less

than a tenth of an acre of agricultural land is expected to be permanently converted to transmission line use. The Applicant plans to immediately begin construction following the issuance of the Certificate and will be completed within approximately six months, around October 2019.

The purpose of this evening's public hearing is to receive comments from the public regarding Paulding's application in this case. It is not intended to be a question and answer session, but instead it is your opportunity to let the Ohio Power Siting Board know what you think about the proposal set forth in the application.

I would also note that the Board's staff filed its report of investigation on February 15th, 2019. This is simply a recommendation of the Board's staff and does not necessarily reflect what the Board's final determination will be in this case.

Tonight's hearing is being transcribed by a court reporter. If you plan to

testify please speak clearly so that the court reporter can accurately reflect your comments on the record. Also, if you've prepared a written statement it would be helpful to provide a copy of that to the court reporter as well.

When you arrived you were offered the opportunity to sign up to testify by Mr.

Zeto and Mr. Butler. After I finish with my introduction I will begin calling witnesses forward that have signed the sign-up sheet and ask you to come to the table and face the court reporter.

Before you present your testimony I will ask that you make an oath or affirmation that what you've said is the truth. I will also ask you to state your name and your address. Your testimony will be considered part of the official record in this case and it will be reviewed by the Board before they make their final decision on the application. Should you decide that you do not want to testify when I call your name, you can merely pass to the next witness. Also, once you finish testifying,

1 or if you are just here to observe, you may 2 leave at any time you wish or stay until the conclusion of the hearing. The Board appreciates your 4 participation in tonight's hearing and we 6 want everyone who wishes to make a public statement to have the opportunity to do so.
