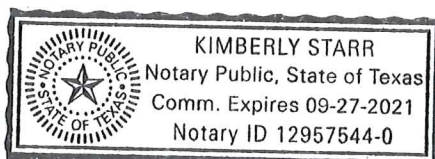
AFFIDAVIT
