Understanding the need to attract additional revenue; increasing a monthly service charge without consumption basis is effectively wrong. Revenue required to maintain or increase infrastructure should never necessarily be passed equally to all simply by virtue of being a customer. If new taps are requiring expansion, then pass those on to the developers. Infrastructure repair/replacement should be a direct cost related to consumption. Tier consumption (much like electricity) if necessary (higher consumption higher costs) but do not impart charges upon low or no consumers. I would recommend eliminating a monthly charge entirely and replacing it with a consumption based infrastructure charge.
