

Background

On April 30, 2019, Ohio Power Company (Company) filed proposed Generation Energy (GENE) and Generation Capacity (GENC) riders in Case No. 18-820-EL-RDR. The proposed tariffs include Standard Service Offer (SSO) generation rates, Time of Day (TOD) generation rates and Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) generation rates.

The proposed SSO and TOD rates include the results of the most recent auction held March 5, 2019, approved by the Commission on March 6, 2019, in Case No. 17-2391-EL-UNC. The proposed PIPP generation rate reflects the results of the PIPP auction held April 9, 2019, and approved by the Commission on April 10, 2019, in Case No. 16-1031-EL-UNC.

The Company requests that the proposed tariffs become effective on June 1, 2019.

Staff Review and Recommendations

Staff has reviewed the proposed tariffs filed on April 30, 2019 and finds that the tariffs appear to be in compliance with Commission Orders and accurately reflect the appropriate auction results.

Conclusion

The Staff recommends that the proposed tariffs filed on April 30, 2019, be approved and become effective June 1, 2019.
