BRATENAHL RESIDENTS' RESPONSE TO JOINT MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND PROPOSED SCHEDULE FOR POST-HEARING BRIEFING

Bratenahl Residents W. Susan Dempsey and Robert Maloney (the "Bratenahl Residents") submit this response to the join motion of Icebreaker Windpower, Inc., the Staff of the Power Siting Board, the Business Network for Offshore Wind, Inc., the Sierra Club, the Indiana/Kentucky/Ohio Regional Council of Carpenters, and the Ohio Environmental Council ("Movants") to extend the procedural schedule in this case to May 14, 2019 to accommodate the filing of a revised stipulation in this case. The Bratenahl Residents do not join in the stipulation to be presented to the Board. Their opposition to the granting of a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Icebreaker project remains. As a result, the Board will need to set a post-hearing briefing schedule. The Bratenahl Residents propose that the parties simultaneously file their initial post-hearing briefs on or before Friday, June 21, 2019¹; simultaneous reply briefs should be due on or before Friday, July 12, 2019.

The Board conducted the evidentiary hearing in this case over the course of seven (7) days, from September 24 through October 2, 2018. At the completion of the hearing, the parties agreed, and the ALJ ordered, that initial post-hearing briefs should be filed on or before

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¹ The Bratenahl Residents' primary counsel is out of the country from June 8 through June 15, 2019. It would be neither realistic nor fair to require that original briefs be submitted before June 8. It has been over six (6) months since the completion of the evidentiary hearing. The testimony and evidence is no longer fresh in counsel's mind. Many hours must be devoted to a detailed review of the hearing transcripts, exhibits, expert reports and cited scientific literature to adequately prepare the post-hearing briefs. No extensions of the procedural schedule were sought by the Bratenahl Residents. They are entitled to a sufficient amount of time to prepare appropriate post-hearing briefs.

November 30, 2018 (approximated 60 days after the completion of the hearing), and reply briefs

should be filed on or before January 8, 2019 (five (5) weeks after the initial briefs).

Icebreaker sought, and received, six extensions of the procedural schedule in this case (on

11/21/18, 12/7/18, 1/14/19, 2/19/19, 3/8/19, and 5/8/19²) to engage in discussions with OPSB

Staff to attempt to resolve Staff's opposition to Icebreaker's application. According to

Icebreaker, it has reached an agreement in principle regarding Staff's objections to its application

and will be submitting a stipulation regarding that agreement. Icebreaker and the Staff thereafter

sought an additional one-week extension, until May 15, 2019, so that they could finalize their

stipulation and file an executed copy with the Board.

As stated, the Bratenhal Residents have not agreed to the revised stipulation and are not

parties to the proposed settlement. Thus, the Board needs to establish a post-hearing briefing

schedule so that the Bratenahl Residents may finalize the prosecution of their opposition to

certification of the Icebreaker project and brief the issues litigated during the evidentiary hearing.

Consistent with the time frames of the original post-hearing schedule agreed-to by the parties and

ordered by the ALJ herein, the Bratenhal Residents suggest that initial post-hearing briefs be

filed on or before June 21, 2019, and that reply briefs be submitted on or before July 12, 2019.
