Report on Service Disconnections for Nonpayment


Dear Sir/Madam:

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO" or the "Commission") issued a notice dated May 15, 2019 under Case No. 19-974-GE-UNC directing all energy companies subject to R.C. 4933.123 to file a written report on service disconnections for nonpayment on or before June 30, 2019 for the 12-month period ending on the preceding May 31 (the "Order").

Choice Energy LLC d/b/a 4 Choice Energy LLC ("Choice" or the "Company") is a Competitive Retail Electric Service Provider with all its customers under utility consolidated billing and purchase of receivables by the electric distribution utility ("EDU"). Under the utility consolidated billing program all Choice's customers are subject to the EDU's billing process and collection policies, and, therefore, Choice does not, and has no ability to, disconnect any of its customers for nonpayment and has no information on its customers' billing and collection experience with the EDU.
