I live very near the Butler-Preble County line. The installation of two solar farms by Alamo Solar I, LLC would create not only clean energy but a potential economic boon for many of our struggling farmers who can no longer profitably cultivate or lease their land for corn or soy. The Alamo Solar projects provides a reasonable case to try out solar energy for Southwest Ohio in a region that needs energy and economic diversification. Solar farms have minimal impact on soil and environmental quality - less so than plowing, fertilizer, and herbicides/pesticides - and require no additional water resources to operate once installed. Unlike wind, there is no noise pollution. I welcome this development as a resident of southwest Ohio and hope to see sites expanded into northwest Butler County.
