I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission grants the joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice as the parties represent that all issues and claims have been resolved.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, services, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory. Respondent, The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02.

{¶ 3} On October 17, 2018, Christine Summers and Larry Moore (Complainants) filed a complaint against DP&L alleging, among other things, that DP&L inappropriately charged the account associated with Complainants' address for a night light.

{¶ 4} On November 6, 2018, DP&L filed its answer to the complaint, denying the allegations of the complaint and setting forth several affirmative defenses.

{¶ 5} A settlement conference was scheduled for and held on December 11, 2018. On and after that date the parties engaged in settlement discussions.

{¶ 6} On June 5, 2019, Complainants and Respondent filed a joint motion to dismiss. In the motion, the parties advise the Commission that they have resolved all issues and claims arising in connection with the matters set forth in this proceeding. Accordingly, the parties jointly request that this complaint be dismissed with prejudice as a settled case.

{¶ 7} In view of the settlement of the complaint, the Commission finds that this matter should be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record.

III. ORDER

{¶ 8} It is, therefore,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That the joint motion to dismiss be granted and that Case No. 18-1561-EL-CSS be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,

{¶ 10} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
