I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Ohio Power Siting Board grants the request to withdraw the certificate in this matter filed by Harrison Pipeline Company, LLC.

II. DISCUSSION

{**[1**] Harrison Pipeline Company, LLC (Harrison or Company) is a person as defined in R.C. 4906.01.

{¶ 3} R.C. 4906.04 provides that no person shall construct a major utility facility in the state without obtaining a certificate for the facility from the Ohio Power Siting Board (Board).

 $\{\P 4\}$ R.C. 4906.03(F) instructs the Board to adopt rules that provide for an accelerated review and automatic certification of gas pipelines and associated facilities under certain circumstances. In accordance with R.C. 4906.03(F), the Board has adopted Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4906-6 addressing accelerated certificate applications.

{¶ 5} Ohio Adm.Code 4906-6-02 identifies the types of accelerated applications as either letters of notification or construction notice applications. Accelerated applications are subject to a 90-day automatic approval process.

{**¶ 6**} On May 23, 2019, Harrison filed a notice withdrawing the certificate that had been issued to the Company on April 18, 2018, in this matter. Harrison explains that on

May 20, 2019, the Board approved an amendment application to the Harrison Power Plant Natural Gas Feed Project (Project) in Case No. 19-852-GA-BLN which supersedes the original certificate issued by the Board in this matter. As such, the Project will be built in accordance with the certificate issued in Case No. 19-852-GA-BLN and the original certificate can be withdrawn.

{¶ 7} The Board finds that Harrison's request to withdraw the certificate issued in Case No. 18-73-GA-BLN should be granted and this case should be dismissed and closed of record.

III. ORDER

{¶ 8} It is, therefore,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That Case No. 18-73-GA-BLN be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

{**¶ 10**} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon Harrison and all interested persons of record.
