About at least \$1300 to \$1800 dollars I have lost. The Illuminating Company has a tough way of changing over names with now a cost of \$225. Thats why it has not been changed over for a while

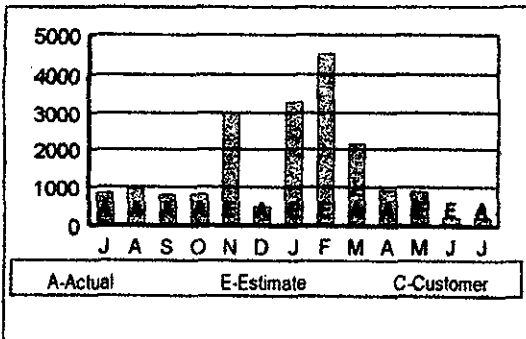

This office represents Michael Cora who disputes the 8/15/2017 accident report submitted by the State of Pennsylvania and reported to you by Marten Transport Ltd.


My client has challenged Marten's filing and reporting of the accident. Marten reported what they received. What they received is wrong. I am submitting my client's version of what happened.
