PETITION OF CBTS TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS LLC FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF THE POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

CBTS Technology Solutions LLC ("CBTS") hereby requests that the

Commission review and overturn a decision of the number Pooling Administrator ("PA")

which denied a CBTS request for numbering resources. On June 13, 2019 CBTS filed a

request with the PA for an NXX in the Cincinnati rate center to establish a Location

Routing Number ("LRN") for a new softswitch that it is deploying. CBTS's request was

denied on the grounds that CBTS has not satisfied the utilization level and months-toexhaust ("MTE") criteria established by the Federal Communications Commission and
outlined in the Central Office Code Assignment Guidelines ("COCAG"). Under the
federal numbering rules, a state commission may overturn the PA's decision based on its
determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for the numbering
resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. For the reasons set forth
below, CBTS submits that the Commission is justified in overturning the PA's decision
and granting CBTS's request for a new NXX to establish an LRN for its new switch.

The new softswitch will replace an existing switch that is being decommissioned. Although the existing switch will eventually be decommissioned, this cannot be done until the new switch is turned up and all lines and services on the existing switch are ported to the new switch. CBTS plans to begin moving subscribers to the new switch during the third quarter of 2019 and expects the transition to be completed by the end of 2019. Because the two switches will be deployed simultaneously during the transition, CBTS requires a unique LRN for the new switch.³

Due to the specific requirements for LRN assignment,⁴ none of CBTS's existing numbers can be used as an LRN. Upon receipt of the new NXX, CBTS will keep the "0" thousand-block and return the remaining blocks to the number pool. CBTS will be able to port numbers from its existing numbering resources to the new switch once an LRN is assigned for the switch, so it does not anticipate the need for additional numbering resources for this switch beyond this initial request. All of the numbers assigned to the existing switch will be ported to the new switch before the old switch is retired.

As shown on the attached Pooling Administration System Worksheet (Attachment A), CBTS's June 13, 2019 application was denied because CBTS does not satisfy the utilization and MTE criteria for receipt of growth numbering resources.
