Emuna Energy is a recognized channel partner of Energy Market Exchange and Dynegy Energy Services and will act as the non-exclusive agent of business customers to price out the customer's electricity usage. Emuna Energy also seeks to become channel partners with other certified electric generators so that the customer has numerous pricing proposals to consider. All billing is done by the certified electric generator, as with all collection. In some limited circumstatnees, Emuna Energy will be the exclusive agent of the business customer for purposes of pricing their electricity usage. Contracts with other customers will delineate whether Enuma Energy is their exclusive agent or wither it is acting on a non-exclusive basis. Emuna Energy will respond to any customer inquires or complaints in accordance with the Commission's rules.
