Re: Cincinnati Bell Energy, LLC – Updated Company Information

(PUCO Docket No. 13-0105-EL-CRS)

#### Dear Secretary Troupe:

In accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 4901:1-24-11, this letter provides notice to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") of material changes to the information regarding Cincinnati Bell Energy, LLC("Cincinnati Bell"), which is a certified Competitive Retail Electric Service provider.<sup>1</sup>

Effective July 15, 2019, Vistra Energy Corp. ("Vistra") acquired Crius Energy Corporation ("Crius"), and became the ultimate parent company of Cincinnati Bell (the "Acquisition").<sup>2</sup> At this time, there will be no changes to the name of Cincinnati Bell.

Vistra, a holding company based in Irving, Texas, operates an integrated power business, with subsidiaries that include TXU Energy, the largest retailer of electricity in Texas, and Luminant, the largest generator of electricity in ERCOT. With the addition of Crius, the combined company serves 3.7 million residential, commercial, and industrial customers across twenty retail markets, and the generation fleet spans a number of states with a diverse portfolio of natural gas, nuclear, coal, and solar facilities.

The combined Vistra creates a platform of a leading integrated power company in the United States, with a strong balance sheet, an efficient operating structure, high-quality assets, and an innovative, market-leading retail presence in key competitive markets. Vistra's retail companies

have a customer-centric focus with an emphasis on customer satisfaction. The Crius Energy portfolio has a high degree of overlap with Vistra's generation fleet and complements Vistra's existing municipal aggregation and large commercial and industrial portfolio. The combined Vistra will be well-positioned to continue providing customers and strategic partners with differentiated products and services.

As a result of the Acquisition, there has been a material change to some of the information for Cincinnati Bell's CRES certification in Ohio. Accordingly, Cincinnati Bell hereby notifies the PUCO of the following material changes to its CRES certification:

- Vistra has updated the contact list to remove Cincinnati Bell personnel who will no longer be working on behalf of Cincinnati Bell and to add Vistra contacts. The updated contacts are provided in <u>Exhibit 1</u> of this letter. The following sections of Cincinnati Bell's CRES certification should be updated accordingly: <u>Sections A-5, A-6, and A-7.</u>
- Vistra has updated the key personnel that meet the technical qualifications. The updated key technical personnel, including their biographies, are provided in <u>Exhibit 2</u> of this letter. The following section of Cincinnati Bell's CRES certification should be updated accordingly: Section D-3.
- An updated corporate organizational chart to reflect the structure post-Acquisition is attached to this letter as <u>Exhibit 3</u>. The following section of Cincinnati Bell's CRES certification should be updated accordingly: <u>Section C-10</u>.
- Vistra has updated the officer slate for Cincinnati Bell. The new officer slate for Cincinnati Bell is provided in <u>Exhibit 4</u> of this letter. The following section of Cincinnati Bell's CRES certification should be updated accordingly: <u>Section A-10</u>.
- Vistra and its affiliated companies are authorized to provide retail and wholesale electric services in the following jurisdictions: Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Illinois, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island and Texas. The following section of Cincinnati Bell's CRES certification should be updated accordingly: Section B-1.
- For purposes of its CRES certification Cincinnati Bell refers PUCO to the following financial information for Vistra as set forth in <a href="Exhibit 5">Exhibit 5</a> of this letter: (1) two most recent annual reports to shareholders; (2) most recent 10-K filed with the SEC; (3) two most recent years of audited financial statements; and (4) acquisition information. The following sections of Cincinnati Bell's CRES certification should be updated accordingly: Sections C-1, C-2, C-3, and C-9.

Please issue a revised CRES certificate for Cincinnati Bell reflecting as necessary these material changes.

John received a master in business administration in finance degree from Southern Methodist University – Cox School of Business and has a juris doctor degree from Columbus School of Law.





Jeff has a degree in management information systems and business management from University of Oklahoma – Price College of Business.




# **Pre-Transactional Simplified Organizational Structure of Vistra Energy Corp.**
