The retail customer supplied with electricity pays for the services through the lockbox. By this arrangement, CNE:

- 1. Pays for the acquisition cost of the wholesale power
- 2. Pays any other companies in the supply chain including Electric Distribution Company, and
- 3. Credits Sustainable Star the net amount excluding all costs described above. This arrangement ensures that there is no risk to the customer. As the associated Dun and Bradstreet report confirms (pages 5-7), the financial risk to the customer from Sustainable Star is non-existent.

The company proposes that the above credit agreement with CNE and attached guarantee, will suffice.
