1. That it is the duly elected body authorized to act for Huron County, Ohio and has taken the required action to intervene, as certified by the attached resolution adopted at its regular meeting of September 19, 2019;
2. That it is a party authorized to intervene pursuant to R.C. 4906.08;
3. That the proposed facility is to be located at least in part in Huron County, Ohio;
4. That it intends to intervene in the proceedings on the grounds that it has an extensive interest in the proceedings as the elected representatives of the citizens of Huron County, Ohio; that said county's interest is not and cannot be represented by another party, existing or otherwise, that its contribution of presenting to the Board the costs and benefits of the project to the citizens of Huron County is essential to a just and expeditious resolution of the issues involved in the proceeding and that it would not unduly delay the proceeding or unjustly prejudice an existing party.

Terry Boose moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Huron County has been informed that an application has been filed with the Ohio Power Siting Board relative to the Firelands Wind, LLC alternative energy project, a portion of said project being located in Huron County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that it is necessary to intervene in the application to protect the interests of Huron County and keep informed of the status of the proceedings relative to this alternative energy project; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is necessary to intervene in the application of Firelands Wind, LLC which is currently before the Ohio Power Siting Board based on all considerations as set forth in the Revised Code and Administrative Code. A portion of the proposed project is to be located within Huron County, Ohio, and the Board is desirous of protecting the interest of the County and staying informed of the status of the project by intervening in said application as it makes its way through the Ohio Power Siting Board; and further

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the foregoing Resolution was adopted and all actions and deliberations of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Huron, Ohio, relating thereto were conducted in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
