## ENTRY

{¶ 1} On September 13, 2019, Empower Gas & Electric LLC (Empower) filed an application for certification renewal as a competitive retail natural gas service (CRNGS) supplier.

{¶ 2} In accordance with R.C. 4929.20 and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-27-10, Empower's application is subject to a 30-day automatic approval process. Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-27-10 further provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission or an attorney examiner may suspend consideration of a certificate application. If an application for certification is suspended, the Commission shall act to approve or deny the application within 90 days of the suspension.

{¶ 3} Staff has requested that the automatic approval process be suspended to allow Empower additional time to provide information requested by Staff.

{¶ 4} The attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 30-day automatic approval process with respect to Empower's application for certification renewal, in order that the Commission and Staff may review the matter further.

{¶ 5} It is, therefore,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for Empower's application for certification renewal as a CRNGS supplier be suspended until further ordered by the Commission. It is, further,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
