

discarded when required; improper storage of poisonous or toxic materials (corrected during inspection); and presence of live insects, rodents, and other pests.

Non-critical included employee had an open beverage (corrected during inspection); outer opening not protected; improper use and/or maintenance of wiping cloths; re-use of singleservice or single-use articles (repeat); nonfood contact surfaces not easily cleanable; non-durable equipment observed (repeat); and facility not maintained clean (repeat).

The following inspections were done Sept. 16:

**Fricker's Perrysburg 103**, 27390 Helen Drive, had two non-critical violations during a followup inspections. They were physical facilities not maintained in good repair; and facility not maintained clean.

**Crossroads Café**, 127 S. Main St., North Baltimore, had two critical and six non-critical violations.

Both critical were corrected during inspection and included employees are not informed in a verifiable manner of their responsibility to report information about their health (repeat); and temperature-controlled foods not being cold held at the proper temperature.

**Jed's Perrysburg Inc.**, 7010 Lighthouse Way, Perrysburg, had two critical and 10 non-critical offenses.

Critical were employees are not informed in a verifiable manner of their responsibility to report information about their health (corrected during inspection); and equipment food-contact surfaces or utensils are unclean. marked; and the presence of pests (ants were observed under the prep sink and flies near the dough-rolling area)

Non-critical included no written procedures for vomiting or diarrheal events; inadequate equipment available for cooling, heating or holding food; non-food contact surfaces not easily cleanable; and plumbing system not maintained in good repair.

**Riverby Hills Golf Club (pro)**, 16571 W. River Road, Bowling Green, had one critical and one non-critical offense.

Critical was insufficient air gap between the flood rim and the water supply inlet.

Non-critical was nonfood contact surfaces not easily cleanable.

**Riverby Hills Golf Club (CH)**, 16571 W. River Road, Bowling Green, had one noncritical offense, which was improper use and/or maintenance of wiping cloths.

Heritage Corner Nursing Home, 1069 Klotz Road, Suite B, Bowling Green, had three critical and one non-critical violation during a follow-up inspection.



American Transmission Systems, Incorporated (ATSI), a FirstEnergy company, is proposing to construct the Wood County 138 kV Reinforcement Project ("Project"). Before ATSI can proceed with construction of this Project, it must obtain the approval of the Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB"). An application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to construct, operate and maintain the facility is currently pending at the OPSB. This letter briefly describes the Project, the OPSB certification process and provides you with notice of the date, time and location of an upcoming public hearing on the Project.

This letter is being prepared and sent in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Rule 4906-3-09(A)(2) which requires ATSI to send a notice to local government officials in the Project area and property owners on, or adjacent to, the routes under consideration for the Project. This notice letter further complies with the specific instructions of the Administrative Law Judge who issued an order on September 4, 2019, setting the date and time for the public hearing on this Project.

In this Project, ATSI is proposing to construct an approximately 6.1 mile-long transmission line from the existing Lemoyne-Midway 138 kV Transmission Line to the Brim Substation. The proposed Project is needed to mitigate thermal loading issues, improve area voltage stability, allow for future load growth, and will help ensure safe and reliable service to the area. Route alternatives under consideration traverse Middleton, Center and Plain Townships and a portion of the City of Bowling Green in Wood County, Ohio.

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

American Transmission Systems, Incorporated ("ATSI"), a FirstEnergy company, proposes to construct the Wood County 138 kV Reinforcement Project ("Project") in a Application submitted to the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. The Project proposes to construct a new 138 kV transmission line that will extend from the existing Lemoyne-Midway 138 kV Transmission Line to Brim Substation. An Application to construct, operate and maintain this facility is now pending before the Ohio Power Siting Board and has been assigned Case Number 18-1335-EL-BTX. Route alternatives under consideration traverse Middleton, Center and Plain Townships and a portion of the City of Bowling Green in Wood County, Ohio, and the general locations of the Preferred and Alternate Routes for the Project are shown on the accompanying map of the area.

(C) The board shall accept written or oral testimony from any person at the public hearing, but the right to call and examine witnesses shall be reserved for parties. However, the board may adopt rules to exclude repetitive, immaterial, or irrelevant testimony.

This marks the second, and final, public notice regarding public hearings for the Project. The first notice was mailed to those persons that received service of a copy of the application and each owner of a property crossed and/or adjacent to the preferred and alternate routes, on April 23, 2019. As part of the procedural requirements associated with the OPSB review of the application, ATSI sent notification letters of the submittal of the application on April 18, 2019 to local public officials in the Project area and on April 23, 2019 to all property owners on, or adjacent to, the transmission line routes being considered for the Project. On May 23, 2019, the original public hearing for this Project was cancelled to give the OPSB more time to collect information on the Project. On September 4, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge rescheduled the public hearing. We are providing this notice to you in response to the setting of the public hearing and in accordance with the Administrative Law Judge's Order. - B. An evidentiary hearing commencing on Thursday, November 7, 2019, at 10:00 a.m., in Hearing Room 11-D, at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

At the local public hearing, members of the public will be given an opportunity to comment on the proposed Project. The OPSB will issue a final decision after the conclusion of the hearings. If the OPSB approves the Project, construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in February 2020. ATSI representatives will contact property owners prior to starting any construction work on their property.

Please note that the case number, Case No. 18-1335-EL-BTX, should include in any correspondence with the OPSB on this Project to ensure that comments are included in the record of the proceeding.
