Dear Mr. Fowler:

We are once again following up on the Crossroads Wind Farm located in Greenwich Township, Huron County, Ohio. Swift Current has not submitted a Road Use Maintenance Agreement (RUMA) for review since a preliminary RUMA was submitted in October of 2018. Our last request for the RUMA was in a letter dated August 28, 2019. We received a letter response from Matthew Birchby on September 5, 2019 stating that the project will use only state routes and that a draft RUMA will be submitted within a week. We still have not received any documents.

Our office is responsible for maintaining the local infrastructure and making sound fiscal decisions for the tax payers of Huron County. A RUMA is designed to protect the local road system and is not only for oversized or overweight vehicles, but it is for all traffic associated with the project. We would like to know what measures are being taken to prevent and monitor construction traffic from using our local road system until a RUMA is in place. In addition, we have not been provided any type construction schedule.
