
The Hillcrest Solar Project (the Project) obtained a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (CECPN) from the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) on February 15, 2018 (17-1152-EL-BGN). An Order on Certificate was obtained on February 21, 2019 (18-1267-EL-BGA) authorizing a project size increase from 125 MW to 200 MW. Part of the approval certificate included the following condition:

Condition 25) Comply with any drinking water source protection plan for any part of the facility that is located within an Source Water Protection Areas (SWPA) of a local village or city.

The Project is partially located with the boundaries of the Mt. Orab Public Water System (PWS) established by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) (https://epa.ohio.gov/ddagw/swap#114912862-overview-and-frequently-asked-questions). The Mt. Orab PWS does not have a Source Water Protection Plan registered with the EPA as of the latest update (April 2019). The Ohio EPA and the Ohio Department of Commerce Bureau of Underground Storage Regulations (BUSTR) have adopted regulations that restrict specific activities within these designated areas. The construction and operation of the Project are not restricted activities for a groundwater or surface water SWPA.

The Project will not include components or regulated activities under EPA rules for SWPAs and does not anticipate any disruption or adverse impacts to public or private water supplies during the construction or operation of the project. Specifically, the project would not involve work more than approximately eight (8) feet below the ground surface, operation of the project would use very little water, and the project would not generate any wastewater discharges. The Project will comply with all standard EPA rules for SWPAs.

The Project will require minimal water use and include one operation and maintenance facility with running water and a septic system. The Project will follow all applicable water quality protections under the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System Permit during construction and will require ground disturbance only for period maintenance activities. As a result, the Project will be compliant with the EPA rules regarding SWPAs and Condition 25 of the OPSB Certificate.
