## **MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT**

On November 13, 2017, MPower Energy NJ, LLC (“MPower”) was issued a certificate as a Competitive Retail Natural Gas Marketer in Case No. 17-2122-GA-CRS (Certificate Number 17-628G(1)). This certificate expired on November 13, 2019. MPower was unable to apply for renewal of the certificate by that deadline. Pursuant to OAC Rule 4901:1-27-04, any competitive retail natural gas marketer, within sixty (60) days of its certificate’s expiration, may request to extend its previous certificate during the pendency of the review of its new application. Further, that request shall be deemed automatically approved if filed in conformance with OAC Rule 4901:1-27-07.

MPower’s Motion is filed in conformance with the Commission Rules, specifically OAC Rule 4901:1-27-07. Further, only twelve (12) days have elapsed since MPower’s previous certificate expired (November 13, 2019), so MPower is well-within the sixty (60) day time period allowed for such a request. For all of the foregoing reasons, MPower respectfully requests that its Certificate Number 17-628G(1) be extended until its new application is reviewed and issued.
