{¶ 1} Gov. Bar R. XII, Section 2(A) provides rules governing eligibility to practice pro hac vice in Ohio. Pursuant to Gov. Bar R. XII, Section 2(A)(7), motions for admission pro hac vice must be accompanied by a certificate of pro hac vice registration furnished by the Supreme Court Office of Attorney Services.
