On December 16, 2019, tariff pages for the Ameritech Operating Companies were filed with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") under Transmittal No. 1883. This filing in the F.C.C. No. 2 Tariff became effective on December 31, 2019.

With this filing, Ameritech is proposing to cease offering an optional feature of its Intercept Referral Service. Intercept Referral Service is provided when a customer's telephone number is temporarily or permanently disconnected or changed. Calls to the intercepted telephone number are provided a recorded message, indicating that the number has been changed, and, if available and/or the customer elects, information such as the new telephone number is provided.

Effective on or after December 31, 2019, Ameritech will no longer offer the ability for customers to customize their recording, such as providing their new telephone number, by removing the word "operator" from the rate category description. 

6. Switched Access Service (Cont'd)

6.1 General (Cont'd)

6.1.3 Rate Categories (Cont'd)

(B) End Office

The End Office rate category provides the local end office switching functions necessary to complete the transmission of Switched Access communications to and from the end users served by the local end office. The End Office rate category includes the Local Switching and Information (i.e., Directory Assistance) rate elements. In addition, certain end office optional features are provided at charges set forth in Section 6.9.2(A)(1). Directory Assistance Service and the applicable rates for it are set forth in Section 9.

(1) Local Switching

The Local Switching rate element provides for (1) local end office switching, i.e., the common switching functions associated with the various Switched Access Service arrangements and (2) intercept functions, i.e., the termination of certain calls at a Telephone Company intercept recording. (D)

It is divided into two distinct categories: LS1 and LS2. The first category, LS1, provides local switching for Feature Groups A and B except when used in conjunction with Dedicated Access Line Service for terminating traffic at end offices. The second category, LS2, provides local switching for Feature Group D, 800 Access Service, 900 Access Service, and for Feature Groups A and B when used in conjunction with Dedicated Access Line Service for terminating traffic at end offices.
