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On March 31, 2016, in Case No. 14-1297-EL-SSO, the Commission issued an Opinion and Order that approved the application of Ohio Edison Company, the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and the Toledo Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy) for authority to establish a standard service offer pursuant to R.C. 4928.143 in the form of an electric security plan (ESP). On October 12, 2016, in its Fifth Entry on Rehearing, the Commission authorized FirstEnergy to implement a distribution modernization rider (Rider DMR). The Commission, in its Eighth Entry on Rehearing (August 16, 2017), further directed Staff to conduct an ongoing review of the use of the Rider DMR during the term of the ESP.

In an Entry issued on January 24, 2018, in Case No. 17-2474-EL-UNC, the Commission selected Oxford Advisors, LLC (Oxford) as the third-party monitors to assist Staff in performing the compliance review of FirstEnergy's Rider DMR. As part of the Commission's prior direction, Oxford is required to file a final report after the termination of Rider DMR or its extension. The filing date of the final report is currently set as February 25, 2020. Staff hereby requests an extension of the filing date to March 31, 2020. The reasons for this motion are set forth in the accompanying Memorandum in Support.
