{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Walid S. Diab (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-07, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On January 9, 2020, Respondent requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled upon the filing of a request for administrative hearing.

{¶ 4} By Entry dated January 23, 2020, the attorney examiner instructed the parties to participate in a prehearing conference on February 25, 2020.

{¶ 5} During the prehearing conference on February 25, 2020, Respondent requested a continuation of the conference. The attorney examiner finds the request reasonable, and consequently, reschedules the prehearing conference to April 14, 2020, at 11:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight time. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact Respondent by telephone.
