Background

Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. ("VEDO") requested approval to revise its Supplier Coordination Tariff reflected in Tariff Sheet No. 56. The proposed revisions reflect the changes that the Commission required as part of its August 28, 2019 Opinion and Order in VEDO's rate case, Case No. 18-298-GA-AIR, *et al.* The Commission directed VEDO to amend its supplier coordination tariff to include provisions which require SCO suppliers to maintain records of customer sales where the solicitation is made directly following any customer call transferred to the SCO supplier by VEDO¹. Specifically, the records shall include the customer name, address, account number, contract price, contact term, type of contract (i.e., fixed, variable, introductory, or other appropriate description), and termination fee, if any, as well as a recording of the full sales call.

Staff Analysis

Staff reviewed VEDO's proposed changes to its Supplier Coordination Tariffs to verify that the changes complied with the Commission's Opinion and Order in VEDO's rate case. Staff found that VEDO's proposed changes do comply with the Commission's directive. In addition, VEDO had to make certain other mechanical adjustments to its Supplier Tariff that involve relocating existing tariff language to subsequent pages as a result of the revisions.

Staff Recommendation

Staff believes that the proposed changes are consistent with the Commission's Opinion and Order. In addition, Staff believes that the other proposed changes did not change the requirements of the tariff. Staff recommends approval of VEDO's application in this case.
