{¶ 1} Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke or the Company) is an electric distribution utility as defined by R.C. 4928.01(A)(6) and a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 2} Pursuant to the directives of R.C. 4928.143(F), the Commission is required to evaluate the earnings of each electric utility's approved electric security plan to determine whether the plan or offer produces significantly excessive earnings for the electric utility.

{¶ 3} On May 15, 2019, Duke filed an application for the administration of the significantly excessive earnings test, as required by R.C. 4928.143(F) and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-35-10 for 2018.

{¶ 4} By Entry issued January 23, 2020, the attorney examiner, among other things, established a procedural schedule and set this matter for hearing on March 18, 2020.

{¶ 5} Due to scheduling conflicts at the Commission, the attorney examiner reschedules the hearing for May 7, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission offices, Hearing Room 11-D, 11th floor, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793. The parties should register at the lobby desk and then proceed to the 11th floor in order to participate in the hearing.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the hearing be rescheduled to May 7, 2020, in accordance with Paragraph 5. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
