Entered in the Journal on March 17, 2020

{¶ 1} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.

{¶ 2} Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison or Respondent) is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.26. Accordingly, Ohio Edison is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.

{¶ 3} On February 18, 2020, John Shreve (Complainant) initiated a complaint against Ohio Edison alleging, essentially, unjust and unreasonable billing practices.

{¶ 4} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(B), a copy of the complaint was mailed to Ohio Edison on February 19, 2020, directing Ohio Edison to file its answer and any other responsive pleading within 20 days after February 19, 2020.

{¶ 5} A review of the Commission's records reveals that Ohio Edison has not filed any responsive pleading as required by Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(B).

{¶ 6} Ohio Edison is ordered to file its answer and any other responsive pleading in this matter within 20 days after receipt of this Entry.

{¶ 7} It is, therefore,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That Ohio Edison comply with the finding in Paragraph 6. It is, further,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
