Firelands Wind, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Apex Clean Energy Holdings, LLC, is proposing to construct a wind-powered electric generation facility located in Groton and Oxford Townships, in Erie County, Ohio, and Lyme, Ridgefield, Sherman, Norwich, and Richmond Townships, in Huron County, Ohio (Emerson Creek Wind Project). The facility will have a total generating capacity of approximately 297.66 megawatts of electricity. Firelands filed an application with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) for a certificate to construct, operate,

In December 2019, the OPSB established the procedural schedule in this case. The initial and second notices regarding the proposed wind-powered facility and hearings scheduled for March 18, 2020 in Bellevue, OH (local public hearing), and April 14, 2020 in Columbus, OH (evidentiary hearing), were published in the Sandusky Register and the Norwalk Reflector on January 7, and March 3, 2020, respectively.

On March 11, 2020, the OPSB, citing Executive Order 2020-01D issued by Governor Mike DeWine declaring a state of emergency in Ohio, to protect the well-being of Ohioans from the dangerous effects of COVID-19, suspended all activity in the Firelands Wind case and postponed the hearings for the wind-powered facility that were scheduled for March 18, 2020 in Bellevue, OH and April 14, 2020 in Columbus, OH. The OPSB stated that the hearings in the Firelands Wind wind-powered facility case will be reschedule for a later time and that new public notices will be sent in advance of those hearings.
