RE: *In the Matter of Aqua Ohio, Inc. to Amend Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 35*

Dear Docketing Division:

In an Order issued on December 18, 2019, the Commission directed Aqua Ohio, Inc. (Aqua) to file an application to amend its certificate to update the metes and bounds description of its Struthers Division. On February 13, 2020, Aqua filed an application to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 35 to reflect an updated metes and bounds description of its Struthers Division. The revisions represent technical corrections to the metes and bounds description. They are not associated with any proposed expansion area for Aqua's service territory and require no change to the existing Tariff. On April 15, 2020, Aqua amended its application to incorporate revised metes and bounds descriptions for the Struthers Division, a revised map of the Struthers Division Service Area with the City of Campbell and a metes and bounds description for the City of Campbell.

Staff reviewed the application for compliance with the rules established in Ohio Adm. Code 4901:1-15-07. The amendments adjust the Struthers metes and bounds along with the map so that it matches the current outline of the municipality of Campbell. Staff verified that the revised map reflects the revised metes and bounds. Staff finds that the amended metes and bounds and the associated map of Struthers and Campbell systems complies with Ohio Adm. Code requirements.

Staff recommends to the Commission that they approve Aqua's application as amended on April 15, 2020. Staff further recommends to the Commission that they require Aqua to continue working with Staff to address discrepancies between the metes and bounds

descriptions and maps of Aqua's other service areas.¹ This review should culminate in a single case filing to amend Aqua's certificates, metes and bound descriptions, and maps, as necessary, to reflect all technical corrections.
