On February 06, 2020, The Cleveland Clinic Foundation filed a joint application to commit existing demand reduction, demand response, and energy efficiency programs for integration with the electric utility's programs (EE/PDR Historic Mercantile Program).

In Case No. 10-0834-EL-EEC, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio developed the EE/PDR Historic Mercantile Program. While the program typically provides for an automatic approval process for applications that are filed under this program, the Commission has ordered that such timing requirements be tolled during Ohio's current state of emergency and for fourteen days thereafter.¹

Staff has reviewed the application, including the project type, installation date, energy savings, and any supplemental information filed by the applicant(s) and has found no reason to deny the application. Therefore, Staff recommends that this application be approved by the Commission.
