{¶ 1} On April 14, 2020, the above-captioned application was filed pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F) for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility as defined by R.C. 4928.01(A)(35).

{¶ 2} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F)(2) provides that if the Commission takes no action with respect to an application within 60 days of filing, the application is deemed automatically approved on the 61st day after the date filed.

{¶ 3} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F) further provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission may suspend the certification of an application. The attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 60-day approval process for this application, in order for the Commission and its staff to further review this matter.

{¶ 4} It is, therefore,

{¶ 5} ORDERED, That the automatic approval process be suspended for this application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility. It is, further,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
